

Application for Travel Grant

The introduction of 4 new conference travel awards aims to support attendance of INS members from low/middle income countries at our two annual conferences. The awards target individuals who are conducting excellent research, but who might be otherwise unable to attend due to financial limitations. **Student/trainee or early career INS members who have submitted abstracts for oral or poster presentations are eligible to apply.** Applications will be ranked based on the quality of the abstract with additional consideration given to first time conference attendees, those with limited financial support, and members from low/middle income countries.

Each travel award includes up to \$1500 USD for travel costs (hotel, transport), a waiver for registration fees, and attendance at 1 CE course. Two student/trainee awards and two early career awards are available. You may choose to:

1. Receive all funding up to \$1500 USD as a reimbursement, **OR**
2. Request INS cover the cost for your stay at the conference hotel upfront and request any remaining funding as a reimbursement (up to \$1500 USD total value including cost of hotel).
